

## FRANÇOIS GRIN

### *Currículo*

After a PhD in economics at the *University of Geneva*, François Grin has worked at the Universities of Montréal and Washington (Seattle). From 1998 to 2001, he was the Deputy Director of the *European Centre for Minority Issues* (ECMI) in Flensburg, Germany. He is currently Professor of Economics at the School of Translation and Interpretation (ETI) at the University of Geneva. He is also a visiting professor at the University of Italian Switzerland in Lugano, where he teaches the management of linguistic and cultural diversity.

François Grin has specialised in language economics, education economics, and policy evaluation in these areas. He is the author of some 200 scientific publications and sits on the editorial board of several journals in language policy and educational issues. He has carried out research projects for international organisations (European Commission, Council of Europe, World Bank Institute) and advises various national and regional governments on language policy issues. He is the Deputy Coordinator of the DYLAN research project on “Dynamics of language and diversity management” funded by the European Commission under Framework Programme 6 (<http://www.dylan-project.org>).
